The Court heard arguments on the Petitioner Reddellen Road Neighborhood Association, Inc. (RRNA)'s Motion to Consolidate the above cases on September 14, 2012. RRNA appeared by its counsel, William C. Gleisner, III and J. Steven Tikalsky, and Respondent Wisconsin Department of Resources (DNR) appeared by its counsel, Assistant Attorney General Diane L. Milligan.

Based on the pleadings and the record in this case, the briefs filed by the parties and the arguments for the parties during the September 14, 2012 hearing, and for the reasons stated by the Court on the record at that hearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Cases 10CV5341 and 12CV1751 are consolidated for administrative purposes only.
This means that whenever one case is on the calendar the other case will automatically be on the calendar.
2. By this Order, the Court is not “merging the records” of the two cases.
3. By this Order, the Court does not intend to affect the substantive rights of any party to the above entitled actions.
4. The Court reserves the authority to direct briefs to combine issues that are common to or parallel in both cases.
5. All future pleadings, briefs or other filings in the above entitled actions shall contain the captions of both Case 5341 and 1751 with a notation that they are consolidated for administrative purposes. Duplicate originals of all future pleadings, briefs or other filings shall be filed with both cases.
